Dear Mr. BAKIREY,

On behalf of the Ministry of Transport, Maritime Affairs and Communications of the Republic of Turkey, I would like to present my compliments to the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation.

As is known, in order to prevent violations committed on third country transport operations, invoices started to be inspected in determining type of the transport operation. However, upon the complaints conveyed to our Ministry about the companies which carry out the goods of the global companies in particular, procedure for inspection of 3rd country transport operations changed on 5th March 2018 and these changed were informed to your side through our letter on 7th March 2018.

On the other hand, your letter dated 29th March 2018 on this new practice has been evaluated in detail by our Ministry. In this regard, please be kindly informed that, taking into account the issues mentioned in your letter and in order to facilitate operations of the Russian companies carrying goods of the global companies in particular, following transport operations will be deemed as bilateral operations;

- For the transport operations from Turkey to Russian Federation: in case that in certified export declaration filled by the Turkish exporter, country of departure is stated as Turkey and country of destination stated as Russia,
- For the transport operations from Russian Federation to Turkey: in case that
 in certified export declaration form filled by the Russian exported, country of
 departure and country of arrival are stated as, respectively, Russian Federation and
 Turkey and this document is accompanied with a Turkish or English translation.

However, it is necessary that these documents should be submitted to the related inspecting authorities and in case that they are not submitted or cannot be submitted, the former practice will apply.
